### Eligibility and Details

- CVJC scholarship eligibility includes high school senior students who are children, grandchildren, or great-grandchildren of CVJC members in good standing (i.e., dues paid in the application year plus one previous year.)
- Students who have demonstrated civic duty by volunteering at any CVJC event(s) or a similar form of civic responsibility.
- GPA will not be a determining factor for scholarship eligibility.
- Applicants may pursue various career paths after high school, including trade school, religious studies, or college degrees.

### How this works

- Recipients will be notified of grants in advance. Scholarships will be awarded to the recipients during a ceremony at the Blossom Time Festival.
- All selected applicants will receive a scholarship and a first-year membership in the Chagrin Valley Jaycees.
